Relieve holiday stress

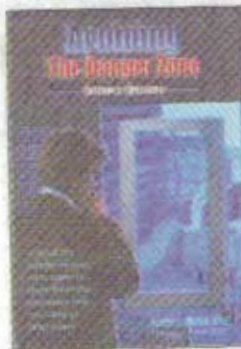
Valley entrepreneur Gillian Benowich is willing to do everything you don't want to this holiday season.
